FDA Approves Drug for Alzheimer's

Exciting news!! The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has approved the use of aducanumab for the treatment of Alzheimer's disease. This is the first FDA-approved treatment for the underlying biology of Alzheimer's, not just the symptoms. Biogen and Eisai announced that the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has granted accelerated approval for ADUHELM[™] (aducanumab-avwa) as the first and only treatment for Alzheimer's disease to reduce the accumulation of amyloid-beta plaques in the brain, a core underlying pathology of the disease. Under this pathway, continued approval for ADUHELM's indication as a treatment for Alzheimer's disease may be contingent upon verification of clinical benefit in a confirmatory trial.
