988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline

988 has been designated as the new three-digit emergency number that will route a call to the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline. When people call, text, or chat 988, they will be connected to counselors that are part of the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline. The current Lifeline phone number (1 800 273-8255 will remain open, according to the 988 Lifeline page. According to the National Center on Law & Elder Rights, callers will be directed according to need. After dialing 988, a caller in need of the Veterans Crisis Line can press "1" to be routed to that resource. A caller in need of Spanish can press "2". Interpretation is available in other languages. For those who have hearing impairment, TTY can be accessed by dialing 711 then 1 800 273-8255 or by using their preferred relay service.

CTE: Chronic Traumatic Encephalopathy

CTE is a progressive degenerative disease of the brain. This is found in people with a history of repetitive brain trauma including symptomatic concussions or asymptomatic concussions (those without symptoms). You may have heard about boxers who suffered from "punch drunk syndrome" or dementia pugilistica. CTE has been confirmed in football (most recently Demaryius Thomas, retired NFL wide receiver) and hockey (Scott Vermillion, major league hockey player), as well as in military veterans who have had repetitive brain trauma. Mike Webster and Justin Strzelcyk (Pittsburgh Steelers), and Christopher Benoit (professional wrestler) all suffered from the effects of CTE – memory loss, confusion, impulse control problems, aggression, anxiety, suicidality, and progressive dementia.

Gas Scams

<u>Fuel cards for \$1.95? Nope!</u> If you see a post on social media claiming that a gas station is offering fuel cards for a small shipping fee, be aware that this is one of the scams that has been making the rounds. Speedway and Shell are two fuel brands that have been mentioned in the scams. The scammer will most likely ask for a credit card so they can bill the shipping fee. As you can imagine, the credit card gets charged for much more than a small shipping fee. The scammer may also ask you to fill out a form. Be cautious. Don't fall for this scam! Another gas scam is the use of a "skimmer" which is a device that is inserted into the credit card slot to steal your information.

Heart Disease and Women

Did you know that heart disease is the leading cause of death for women in the US? "Historically, heart disease was thought of as a man's disease, but the science has proven otherwise" and "Mortality rates show heart disease kills more women than do all forms of cancer combined" according to Stacey E. The New Outbreak: Monkeypox

According to the Centers for Disease control, <u>Monkeypox</u> is caused by a virus that is in the same family of viruses as smallpox. It is not related to chickenpox. Symptoms can include: fever, headache, muscle aches and backache, a rash that can look like pimples or blisters that appears on the body, and/or exhaustion. Monkeypox is spread through direct contact with the rash, respiratory secretions during prolonged contact or contact with items that have been exposed to body fluids. <u>Prevention steps</u> are listed on the CDC website, and can include vaccination. Talk to your health care professional.
