## **Ohio Attorney General's Office**

The Ohio Attorney General's Consumer Protection Section protects Ohioans from predatory and illegal business practices. The section enforces laws that prohibit unfair and deceptive practices including but not limited to: false advertising, shoddy workmanship, and failure to perform services or to deliver goods. The Consumer Protection Section's Economic Crimes division assists local law enforcement and prosecutors in identifying, investigating, and prosecuting consumer fraud of a criminal nature. To further assist consumers and businesses, the section also provides consumer education, business education and a free informal dispute resolution process to resolve consumer complaints, including complaints related to identity theft. Beneficiaries should have received their current product's Annual Notice of Changes so they can begin to prepare for the upcoming AEP.
